**W**ere the horrific events of September 11, 2001 representative of a depraved international order? In a lawless world where cutthroat, nationalistic competition reigns supreme, could the leadership of a nation cannibalize its own people for what they call "the greater national interest," or worse yet, personal gain?

Anyone seeking a better future for our world must recognize the importance of developing and maintaining governing systems (local, national, and global) that promote the welfare of, and remain accountable to, their citizens. Occurrences of political conspiracy, militant terrorism, corruption, and oppression are all indications that there has been a critical failure in those governing systems. When that happens, it is our civic duty to take a step back, come to understand the problem, and develop a plan for corrective action.

David Ray Griffin has dedicated the last 4½ years to helping the American public do just that. Having already established himself as one of the preeminent theologians of our time, he put his reputation on the line to scrutinize what he believed to be an inadequate and possibly disingenuous government investigation into the events of 9/11. Through his lectures and his books (*The New Pearl Harbor* and *The 9/11 Commission Report: Omissions and Distortions*), Griffin's thoroughgoing research and unbiased approach are brought to bear on this troubling period in United States, and world, history.

### **Public Transportation:**

**MUNI** riders: The venue is accessible by the 38 Geary bus. Westbound get off at Franklin St.; Eastbound get off on O'Farrell St. at Van Ness Ave. Or take the 47 or 49 Van Ness Ave. busses; Northbound get off at Geary St.; Southbound get off at O'Farrell St.

**BART** riders can take the MUNI 38 Geary bus at Montgomery St. station.

**Caltran** riders can take the MUNI 47 bus at the San Francisco station.

**Golden Gate Transit** riders can take the 70 or 80 busses and get off on Van Ness Ave. at O'Farrell St.

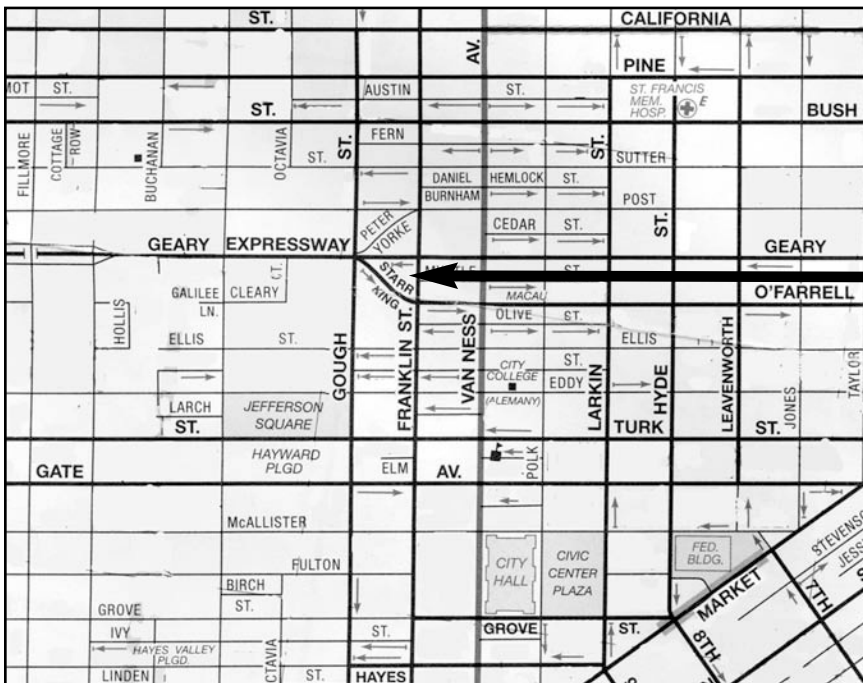
Enter from Post St. between Van Ness Ave. & Polk St.
